

RE Knowledge organiser:**Year 4: Why is the Bible special for Christians?****YEAR GROUP BIG QUESTION: What is important to people in my local community?****Vocabulary**

Bible: A collection of 66 books that Christians believe contain the blueprint for how to live well in the world today

Parable: A made up story Jesus told which has a special meaning

Proverb: a saying which is seen as wise

Commandment: a law from God

Baptism: literally means to cover in water

Communion/Eucharist: special meal remembering Jesus last meal with his followers where Christians remember Jesus death on the cross and what it means to them

The Lord's Prayer: Famous prayer Jesus taught his followers

Sacred: holy or special

Lectern: Reading platform in a church
