What should I know?

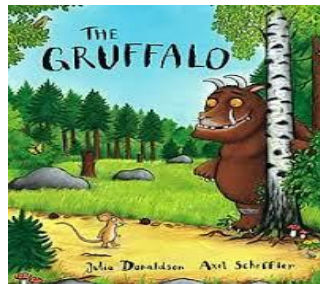
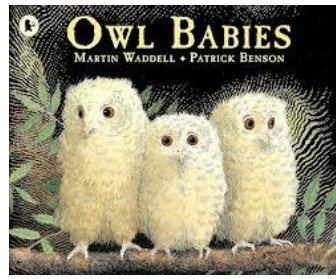
What are the four different seasons called? (Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer)

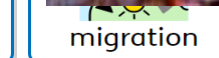
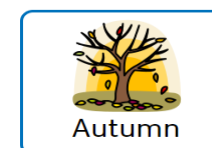
