

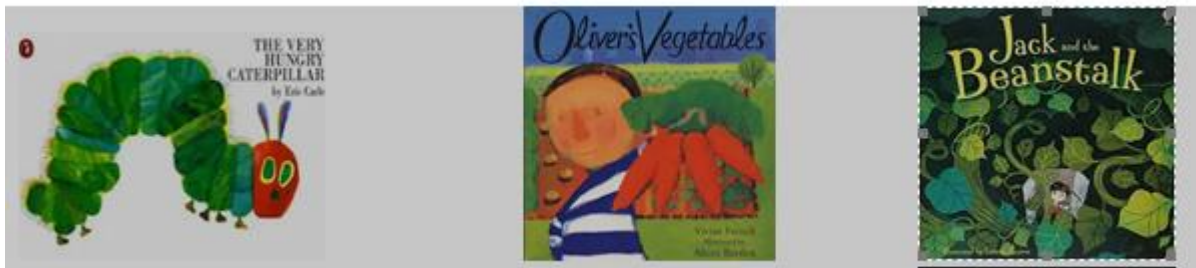

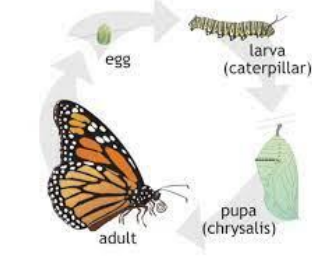
Key Knowledge and Skills

- We need to exercise, eat healthy food, drink water, brush our teeth and clean our hands to stay healthy.

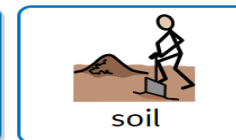
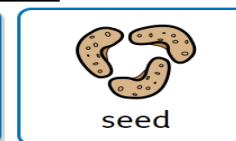
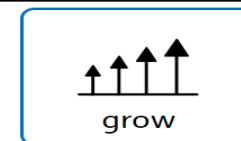
Growing in Action
