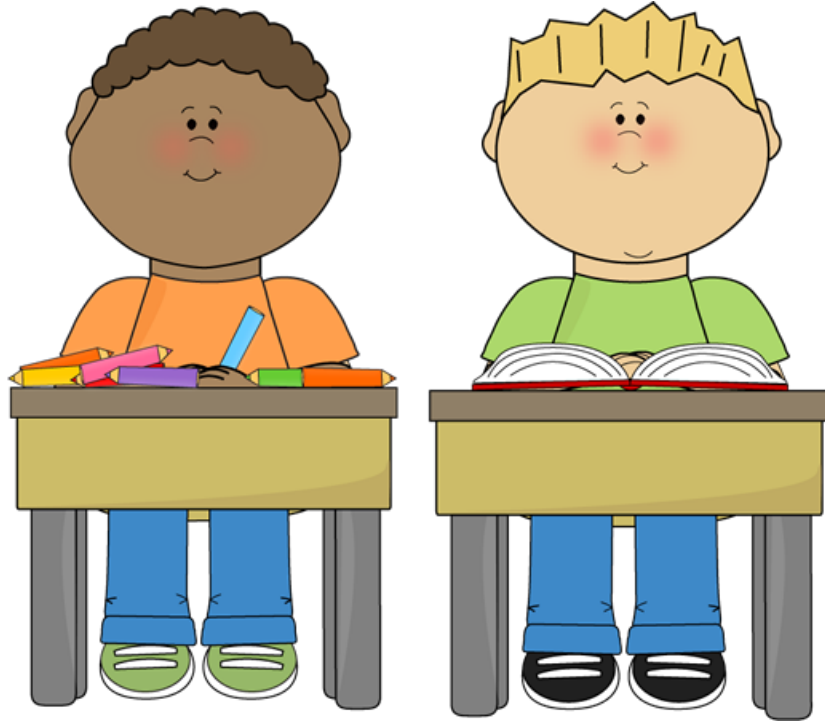

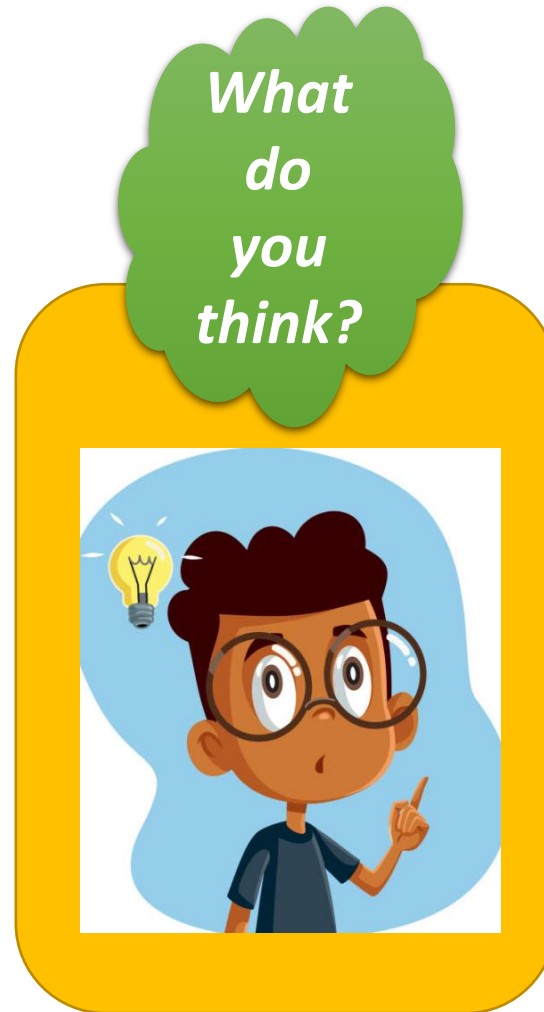

Racism is when people are treated unfairly because of their skin colour or background. It is a kind of discrimination, and it causes great harm to people.



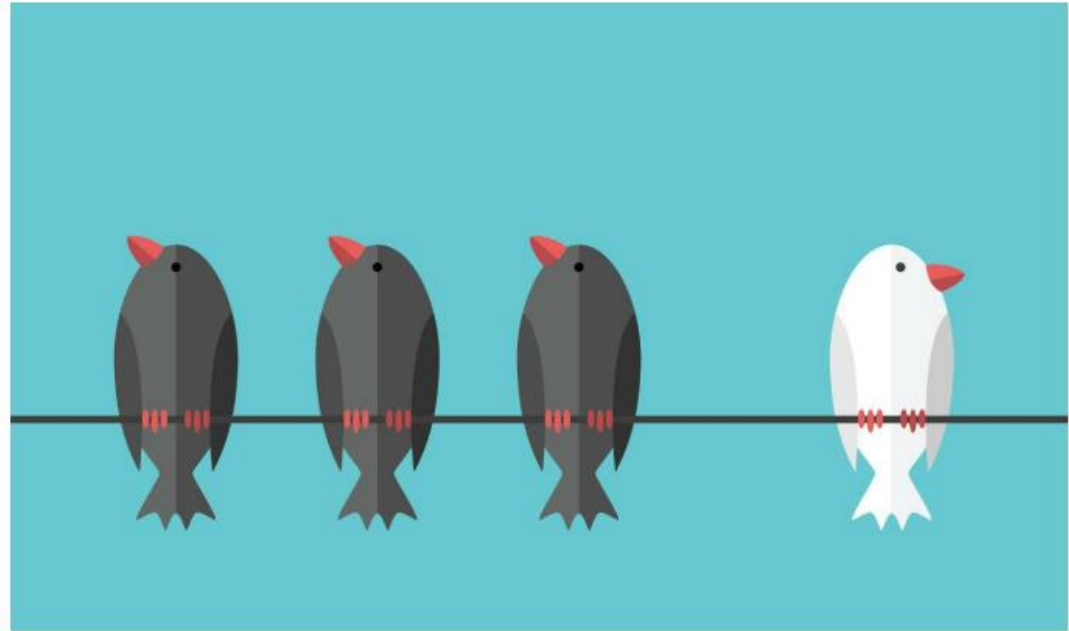
Why might somebody be racist?

Because of this, we tend to develop biases against people who are different to us.

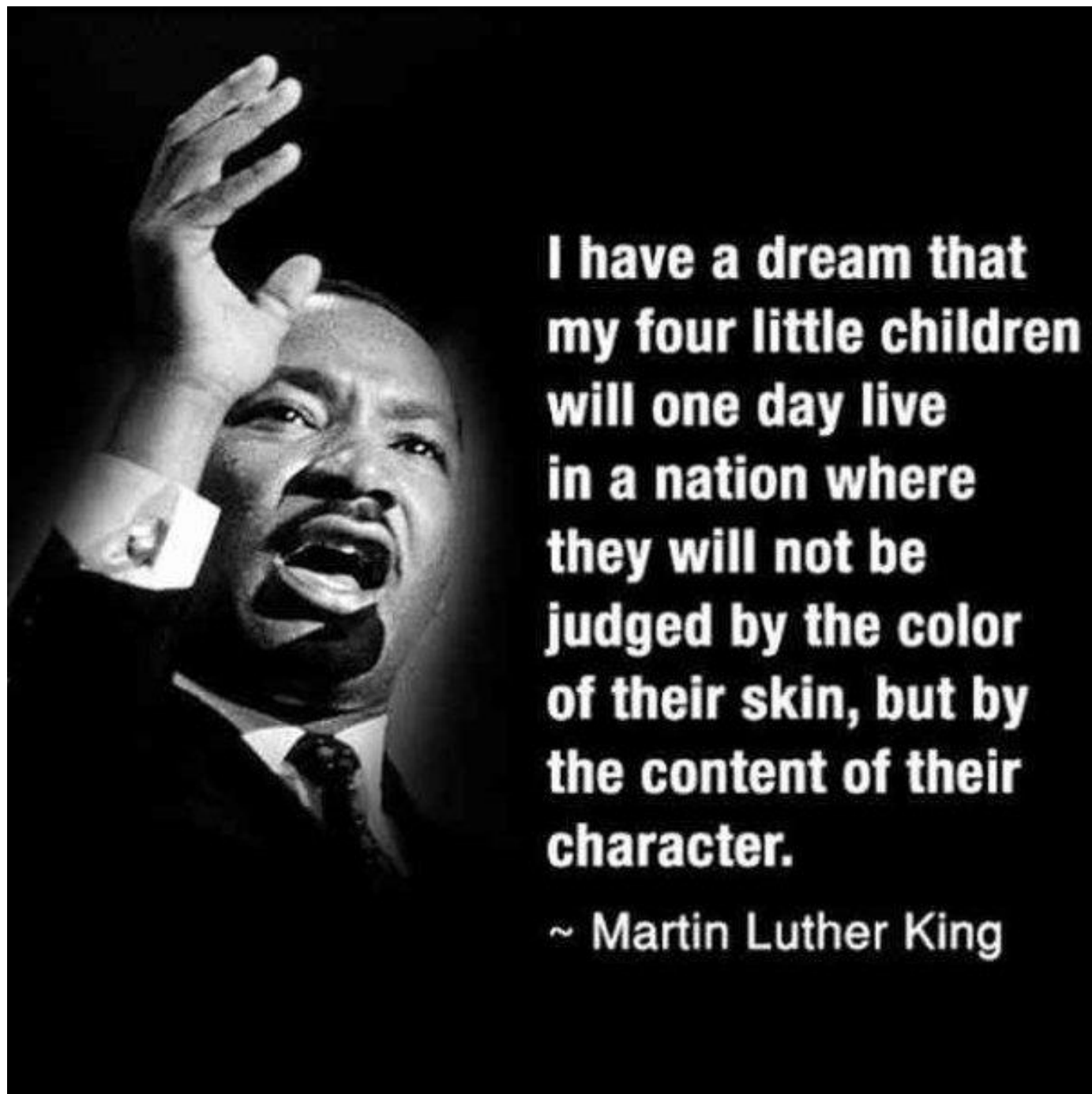
We often call these 'prejudices' which means judging people without knowing their background.

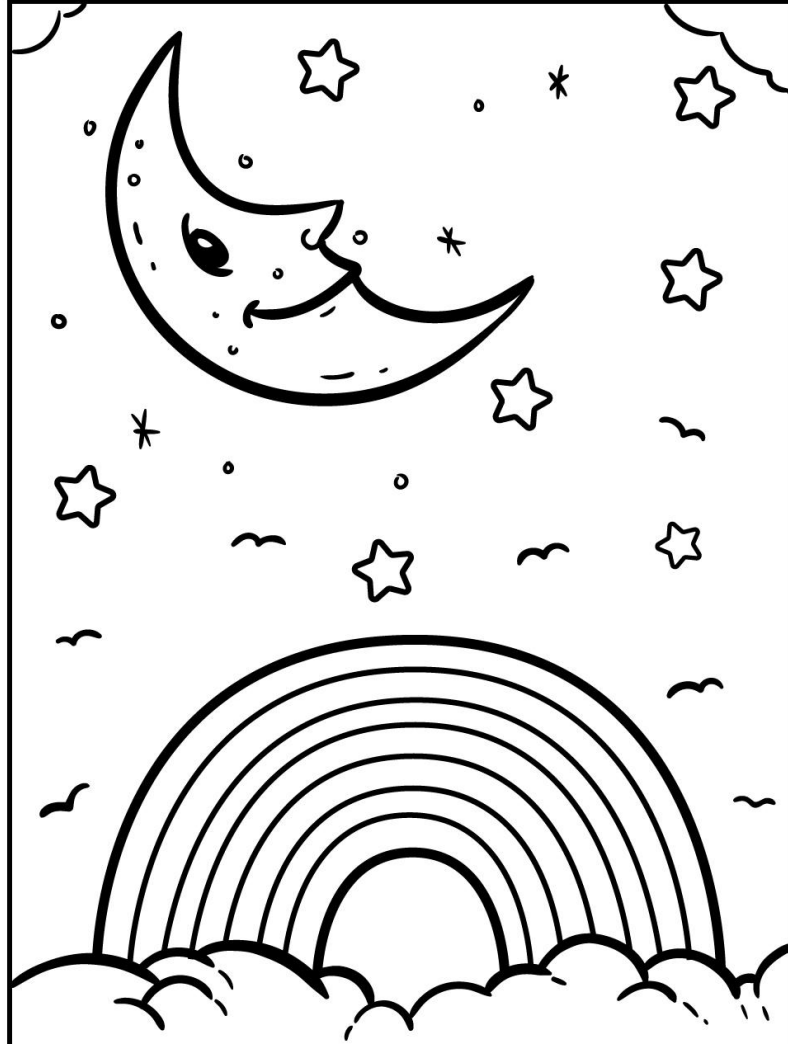
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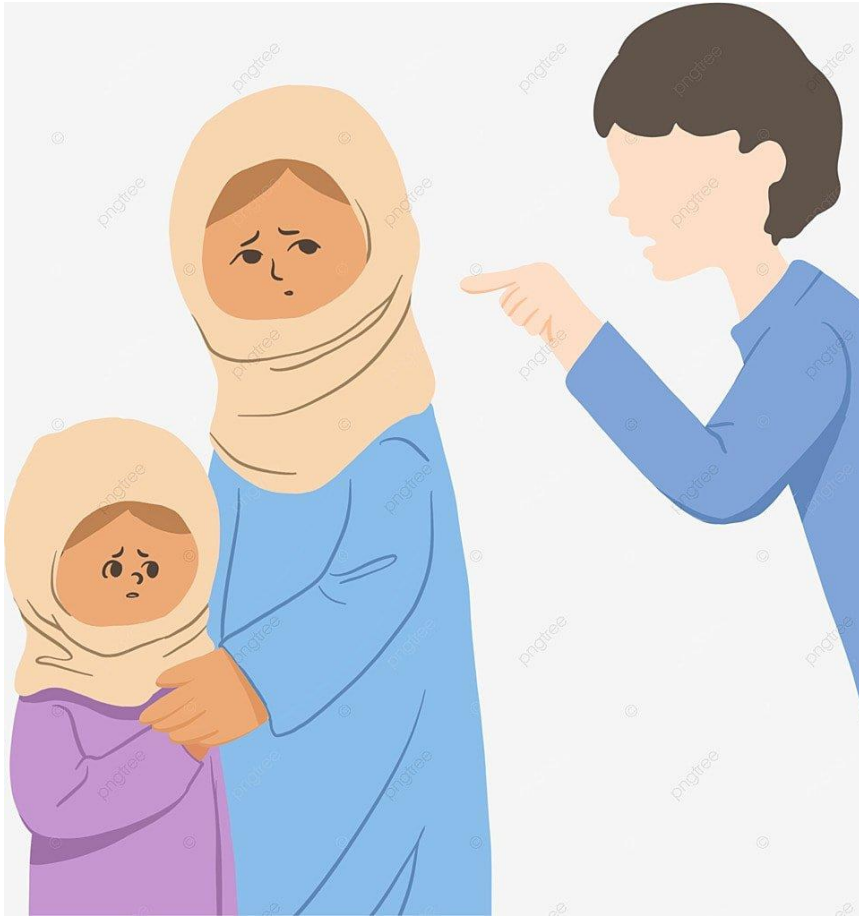
