Catch Me Reading This Christmas with a family member- Competition

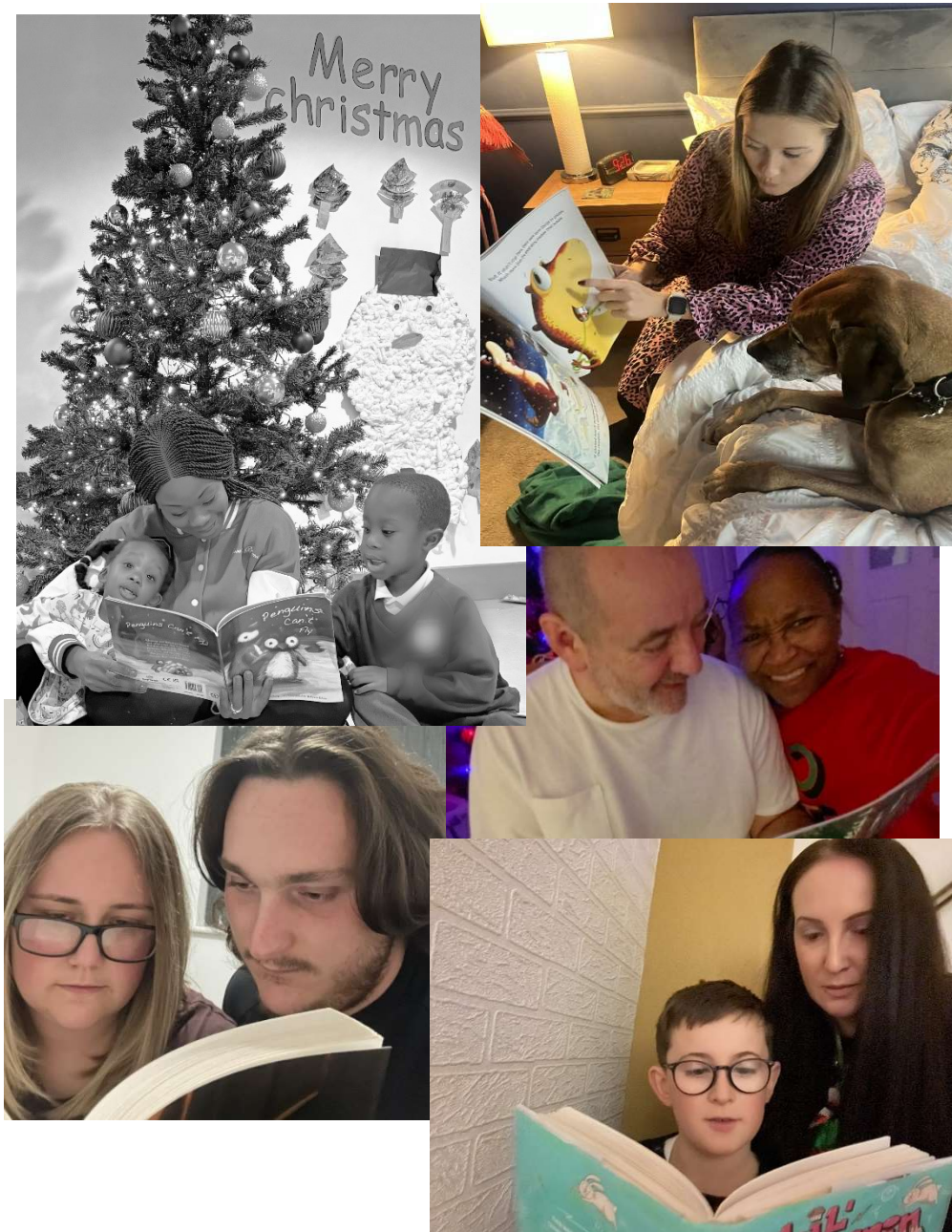
Can you read with a member of your family?

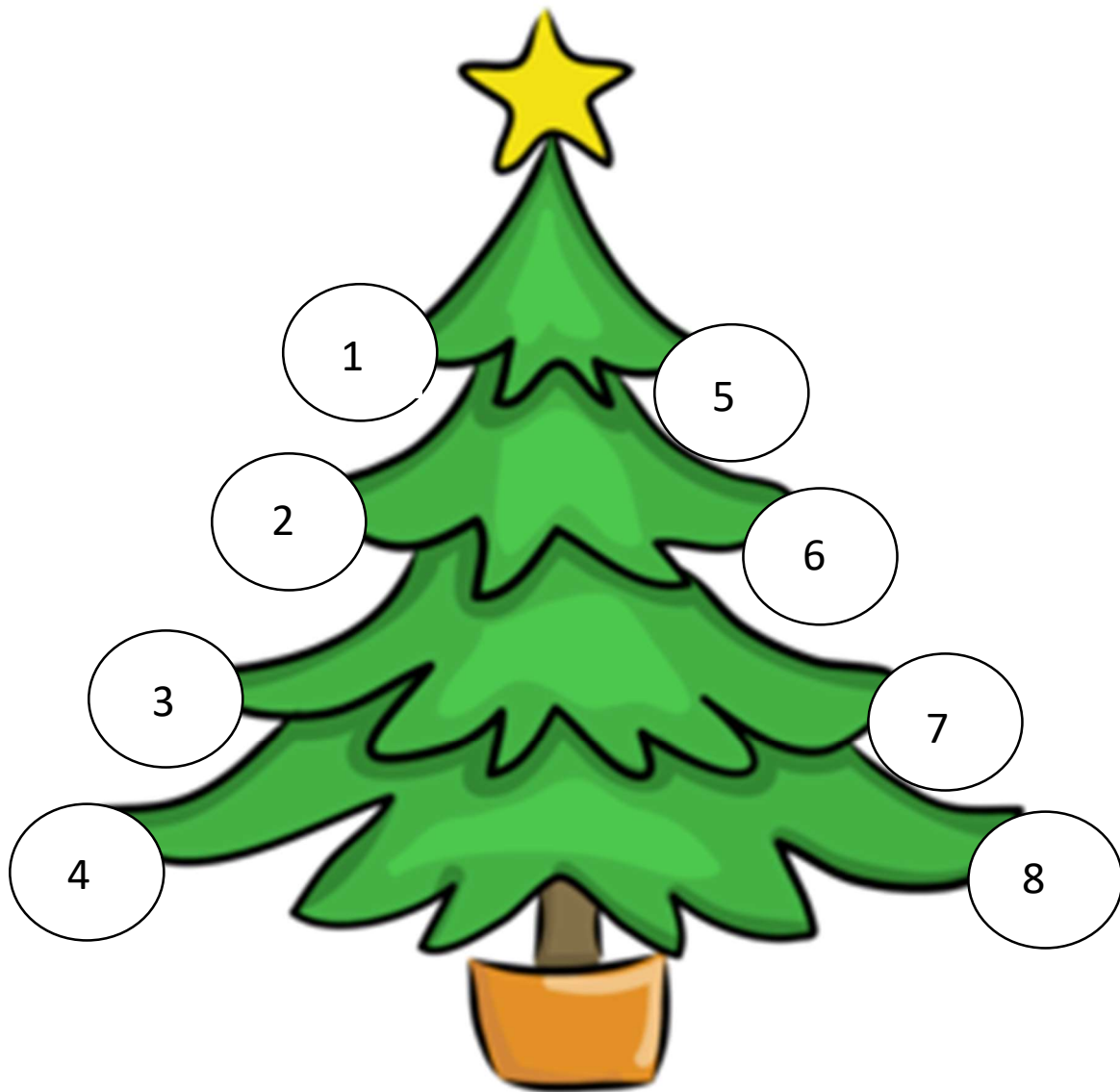
Please take your image and bring it into school on **Monday 8th January 2024** and one child per year group will be selected as the winner.

Activity list

1. Create a character analysis (an exploration of the traits, personality and characteristics of a character within a story) of your favourite character.
2. Summarise your favourite book in 200 words.
3. Read a newspaper, comic or a magazine.
4. Read a non-fiction text and list five things you have learnt.
5. Read a fiction book and create your own ending to the story.
6. Draw a scene from your favourite book.
7. Create your own villain for one of your favourite stories.
8. For a story that you have read, create your own book cover and write a new blurb.

Additional reading homework is outlined above in a Christmas bauble format. You have the option to complete **ALL** tasks or complete a **minimum of four** during this holiday, but one of them **MUST** be a writing task. Please complete them at a time that suits you but by **Monday 8th January 2024**. You may colour the bauble number related to the activities as you complete them. Some of the activities will take longer than others; children have the freedom to choose which task they would like to complete. **Have fun completing the activities!**
