- 1 The height of the mountain Ben Lawers is 1214 m. Ben Nevis is 130 m taller. What is the height of Ben Nevis?
- 2 In Africa, Mount Auasberge is 2485 m high. In Wales, the height of Mount Snowdon is 1400 m less than this. How high is Snowdon?
- 3 The highest mountain in the world, Everest, is 8848 m. The highest mountain in the Alps, Mont Blanc, is 4041 m shorter. How high is Mont Blanc?
- 4 Charles Dickens wrote *Oliver Twist* in 1838. 160 years later, JK Rowling's book *Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets* was published. What year was that?
- 5 William Shakespeare was born in 1564. When he was 35 years old, the Globe theatre was built. What year was this?
- 6 The Battle of Hastings took place in 1066. The battle of the Spanish Armada was 522 years later. When was that?
- 7 On Monday, 845 people clicked on a website to buy tickets for a concert. On Tuesday, the number of people who clicked on it was 1030 more than on Monday. How many people clicked on the website on Tuesday?
- 8 A website had 3562 hits during the year 2012. During 2013 it had 3007 more hits. How many hits did it have in 2013?
