Can you add ing, ed, er and est to these root words?

The spelling rule is:

If the word has 1 syllable, 1 vowel and it ends in 1 **consonant**.. then you **double** the final **consonant**.

You do this before you add 'ing', 'ed', 'er', 'est'.

You **don't** **double** the **consonant** if the word ends in 'tion'.

For example, Sit = sitting.

2) Slim

3) Hit

4) Pat
