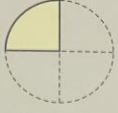
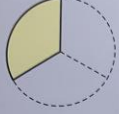

$$\frac{1}{4} \div 3 = \frac{1}{12}$$

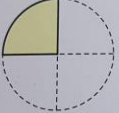

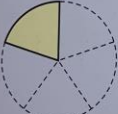
