1. Three children share $\frac{1}{2}$ a pizza. What fraction of the pizza do they each eat?
2. Four children each eat $\frac{1}{6}$ of a pizza. What fraction of the pizza do they eat altogether?
3. Two children share $\frac{3}{4}$ of a pizza. What fraction do they each eat?
4. Two children share $\frac{1}{5}$ of a cheesecake. What fraction do they each eat?
5. Four children each eat $\frac{2}{5}$ of a cheesecake. How much cheesecake do they eat altogether?
6. One child eats $\frac{1}{2}$ a pizza and the other eats $\frac{3}{8}$. How much do they eat altogether?
7. There is $\frac{2}{3}$ of a pizza left. One child eats another $\frac{1}{6}$ of the pizza. How much is left now?
