To be able to discuss writing that is similar to that which you are planning to write.

Success Criteria

- Identify powerful verbs (**a verb is** a word used to describe an action, state or occurrence. Verbs can be used to describe an action (doing something e.g. like the word 'jumping' in this sentence)
- Identify interesting adjectives (**adjectives are** words used to describe and give more information about a noun, which could be a person, place or object).
- Identify expanded noun phrases (**expanded noun phrases are** made up of one noun and at least one adjective. If more than one adjective is used to describe the noun, they are usually separated by a comma).

Below is the description of a dragon. First read the description, underline the **expanded noun phrases** and **powerful verbs** and then draw a picture of the dragon from the description.

The dragon was still and about to attack. His huge, scaly green body moved slowly. Glaring red eyes stared down. Even brave Knights were afraid.
