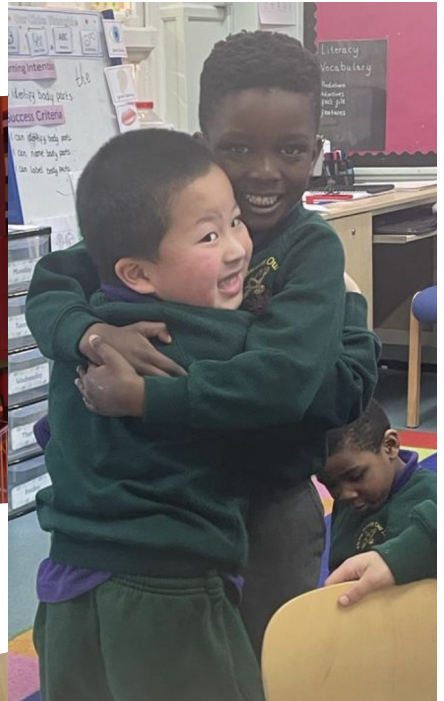

Home Learning

Nursery

- To independently write their name.
- To form letters.
- To go to somewhere new e.g. the beach.
- Listen to staff read aloud.

Reception

- To independently form letters correctly (ascenders and descenders).
- To independently write words using their phonics.
- To recognise tricky words (Type in tricky words on Youtube).
- Listen to staff read aloud.
